



General Terms and Conditions for Photography, Film, and Video Shoots at the Allied Museum

The Allied Museum is responsible for the conservation of the exhibits entrusted to it. Access to the exhibition spaces is therefore subject to the following conditions.

1. The use of flash photography is not permitted.
2. No additional lighting may be directed at objects made of paper or textile.
3. Light sources must be placed at the greatest possible distance from exhibits. Exhibits may be subject to additional light for a maximum of two minutes, using low-level lamps with a maximum of 300 watts.
4. An increase in the room's ambient light is permitted within reason, preferably with indirect lighting.
5. Modifying or moving the exhibits is prohibited.
6. Equipment such as lamps, cables etc. must not be left unattended and must be dressed in such a way to allow the free flow of museum visitors.
7. Crews must comply with the directions of museum guards and other personnel.
